2015 Registration

- Statistics since the beginning of the registration process for the Gymnix Classic 2015:
 - 455: Number of registered gymnasts in the provincial level;
 - 270: Number of registered gymnasts in the national level;
 - 150: Number of registered coaches;
 - More than 50 gymnasts in the international level;
 - 55: Number of registered clubs;
 - 8 : Number of registered canadian provinces.
- Important deadlines :
 - The deadline for withdrawal without medical certificate, with refund, was on December 10;
 - January 10: deadline for modification to an existing registration (10\$ administrative fee);
 - February 10: deadline for medical withdrawals (refund with a 10\$ administrative fee).
