- 2. Top 6 AA Junior & Top 6 AA Senior at Canadian Championships 2019
- 3. Top 6 AA Junior & Top 6 AA Senior at Elite Canada 2020 (if different from CC)
- 4. Invitations following Elite-Canada (identified by National Team Director & the OC)

Our 29<sup>th</sup> edition will be colourful, entertaining and festive. We hope many of you will join us to celebrate the unique sport that is artistic gymnastics. #### 4. MEALS AND ACCOMMODATION

#### 5. REGISTRATION

Registration for the Gymnix Challenge will be online on the platform SportzSoft which will be accessible from the registration page on <u>our website</u>. More info on the registration procedures is in the registration manual.

The registration fees are 180\$ for athletes and \$110 for coaches.

Our goal is to allow all the HP gymnasts to compete in a FIG judged competition. Here is what we ask for registration:

- Junior, Senior and Espoir national team members: To be registered in the Gymnix Challenge. We will later adjust the categories of the athletes who will be named by Gymnastics Canada in the Junior Cup or Senior Cup.
- Athletes aspiring to HP in 2020: To be registered in the Gymnix Challenge. Their official participation in the Challenge will only be confirmed after Elite Canada. Gymnasts that will not obtain their HP standard will be changed to JO 10. Please let us know after registration if you are not interested in your athlete competing in JO10 in the event that she does not obtain her HP status. Those that will be named HP are guaranteed a FIG judged competition for the International Gymnix 2020. Please keep in mind that this competition might not be the Gymnix Challenge.


