Information section for coaches

Accreditations

Accreditations are given at the accreditation kiosk next to the elevator on the ground floor, opposite the reception desk of the Claude Robillard Sports Complex.



Accreditations will be given by club and not individually. A club member is responsible for retrieving the accreditations of the athletes before each competition session. The member of the club can also choose to recover all the accreditations of its club.

Please note that all gymnasts and coaches of the Classic Gymnix 2020 can attend all the competitions (including international competitions) of International Gymnix 2020 free of charge, upon presentation of their accreditation card. They will have access to the general admission sections in the bleachers. If the gymnasts and coaches wish to have booked seats, they can buy tickets in the Club, Gold or Silver sections.



Trainings

Coaches are responsible for informing their athletes about the location of their warm-up. Gyms A and B are located on the ground floor; Gym C is located in the 2nd basement of the Sports complex. If you're not sure, please inquire at the information kiosks at the two entrance doors to the Sports complex.

Musics

Music for all athletes should have been uploaded to SportzSoft. We ask that you have a CD or a USB key with the music with you in case of problems.

Personal belongings



Padlocks: Plan to use a padlock to keep your personal belongings safe in the locker rooms located on the ground floor of the Complex. No outer clothing will be tolerated on the warm-up or competition grounds.

Shoes: Plan to wear sandals or running shoes to move from the warm-up gymnasium to the competition gymnasium.

Therapy

A physiotherapy service will be available in the warm-up and competition area for injuries and emergency taping. Athletes who want a pre-competition taping must provide their own equipment. A sports massage kiosk will also be available to athletes on the 2nd floor from **Thursday March 5 to Saturday March 8 from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.** and **Sunday March 9 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m**.



NEW! Coaches and gymnasts must present themselves at the official IG booth, located on the 2nd floor in the Gymnastics tradeshow, with their accreditation in order to receive their gift.

Food & Drinks

Food will be available to accredited coaches during their presence on the competition field. A supply area will be set up directly on the competition platforms (coaches lounge) during meal times. It is forbidden to take food out of the coaching lounge.




- Coaches who are not in competition during meal times can eat on the 2nd floor of the Sports Complex. Several food kiosks will be at your disposal.

- Note that the IG cafeteria (3rd floor) is reserved for volunteers and officials.

- Water and oranges will be available to gymnasts on the competition platforms.

We ask each coach and each athlete to bring a reusable water bottle. Thank you for helping us in our pursuit of an eco-responsible event.



Here is a tutorial to help you if you were wondering how to buy tickets:

WHICH TICKET(S) SHOULD | BUY?

I am a spectator of the Classique Gymnix

You have no other option than to take a place in general admission (no assigned seats).

A Classique ticket does not allow you to be able to attend international competitions. For this, you must take a ticket which allows you to be able to attend all the competitions on the same day.

I am a spectator of the International competitions

You can buy a general admission ticket valid for international competitions (without assigned seat) or a ticket in the gold and silver

I want to come as a group in the Club area

You should check with your club to find out how many people want to come. You will have the possibility to buy your seats to be all together in the Clubs area (letters R / S / T on the plan).

You will have access to all the competitions of the day and in the 2 gymnasiums.

Your child, as a participant, will have access to all competitions in general admission thanks to their accreditation. There is no need to buy a ticket (unless you want to be placed in the silver or gold zone during international competitions).



Following last year's success, Pixelyst's studio is back at the International Gymnix 2020. An online reservation system is available to book your place in advance, while saving \$5. 275 places will be available for the 5 days of the event. For groups, we recommend booking individual places for the athletes as well as a place for the group pictures.

How much does it cost?

A registration fee to ensure your presence of \$15 is required when booking. Pixelyst will send you a coupon of \$20 applicable on any purchase on March 1st (action, studio and individual or group photos).



You have not booked and you want to do a session?


You can confirm if places are available on computers or phones or by going directly to the studio to make your appointment on site.
